Submission Requirements for The 13th Annual Provincetown International Film Festival June 15 - 19, 2011

The Provincetown International Film Festival (PIFF) was born the same year Provincetown celebrated its 100th anniversary as America's oldest art colony. Today, the renowned Festival remains dedicated to showcasing independent American and international films, offering a full program of full-length and short films curated by a dedicated programming team, with submissions reviewed by a veteran screening committee. If you are interested in submitting your work, please read all the information below and follow the instructions.

- PIFF shows narrative, documentary and animated features and shorts in 35mm, DigiBeta, BETA SP video and PAL (NTSC is preferred).
- Film must have been completed after January 1, 2010.
- Please complete the entry form below, sign and include it with your submission. Entry fee is \$35 for a short (under 40 min.) and \$45 for a feature. There is a student price of \$25 for a short and \$35 for a feature. Students must include a copy of their valid student I.D. with film submission. Payment may be made via MasterCard, VISA, American Express, check or money order.
- Any number of titles may be submitted by an entrant.
 However, each title must have its own separate entry form, review copy and entry fee.
- Student filmmakers can choose to have their film screened in the general submissions or be entered into the Juried Student Short Competition. Please make that selection on the submission form. Student made feature length films will be screened in the general submissions.
- All accepted films are eligible for the HBO Audience Awards.
- A preview copy (DVD NTSC only) must be labeled with the title, running time and contact information (including name, address, phone number and email address). Preview copies will not be returned unless accompanied by a self-addressed, stamped envelope.
- In addition to your DVD submission, please send photos, stills and press kits (web link with high resolution jpegs preferred, but we will also accept DVDs), filmmaker bio, reviews or other publicity materials you may have. If your work is selected, photos will be used for promotion and for the PIFF web site and catalog.

- Acknowledgment of receipt of your entry will be made by email.
 Please include an email address with your submission for this purpose. Preview DVDs and support materials will not be returned.
 You will be notified of acceptance or rejection by May 25, 2011.
- PIFF does not pay rental fees for submitted works which are programmed.
- PIFF will pay return shipping for the film (exhibition copy) within the Continental U.S. ONLY. It is the filmmaker's responsibility to get the film to the festival by June 8, 2011 at the latest.
- The submission deadline (postmarked) is Friday, February 25, 2011.
